The Antlerless Season is limited to West Virginia residents and is open November 25 – December 12 and December 29-31. Prior application is required and the season bag limit is one deer.

Class RM and RRM muzzleloader stamps are only valid for antlered deer.
Bluestone Lake WMA Coopers Rock State Forest	All regulations are the same as private land in the counties where the public lands are located except: all antlered deer taken must have a minimum 14" outside antler spread. The annual bag limit for antlered deer in Buck Gun, Archery and Muzzleloader Seasons combined is one deer. The Special Split Youth/Class Q/QQ deer season is only open on Bluestone Lake WMA. The Antlerless Season is November 25 – December 12 and December 29-31, and the season bag limit is two deer.
Hillcrest WMA	All regulations are the same as private land in Hancock County except: Buck Gun Season is closed. This area has a Special Muzzleloader Deer Season from November 23 – December 5 and during this period only muzzleloaders may be used for hunting deer on the area. All Muzzleloader Season stamp requirements apply. The annual antlered deer bag limit for Archery and Muzzleloader seasons combined is one deer. The Antlerless Season is limited to West Virginia residents and is open November 25 – December 12 and December 29-31. Prior application is required and the Antlerless Season bag limit is one deer. Class RM and RRM muzzleloader stamps are only valid for antlered deer.
Wilson Cove Deer Study Area	All regulations are the same as private land in Hardy County except: Buck Gun Season is closed. This area has a Special Muzzleloader Deer Season from November 23 – December 5 and during this period only muzzleloaders may be used for hunting deer on the area. All Muzzleloader Season stamp requirements apply. The annual antlered deer bag limit for Archery and Muzzleloader Seasons combined is one deer. The Antlerless Season is November 25 – December 12 and December 29-31.
Potts Creek WMA <i>(Jefferson National Forest)</i> Wallback WMA	All regulations are the same as private land in the respective counties where the WMAs are located except: the Archery Season bag limit is two deer. The Antlerless Season and the Special Split Youth/Class Q/QQ deer seasons are not open. Muzzleloader hunting is restricted to antlered deer only. Class RM and RRM muzzleloader stamps are only valid for antlered deer.
Green Bottom WMA	All regulations are the same as private land in Cabell County except: Deer may only be hunted with bows or muzzleloaders and the Antlerless Season is November 25 – December 12 and December 29-31.
