- e. "Property and Procurement Office" means the unit within the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources' Administration Section headed by the Chief Procurement Officer and its personnel.
- f. "Director of the Purchasing Division" means the Director of the West Virginia Department of Administration, Purchasing Division.
- g. "Award Document" means the document signed by the Agency and the Property and Procurement Office and approved as to form by the Attorney General that identifies the Vendor as the contract holder.
- **h.** "Solicitation" means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Property and Procurement Office.
- i. "State" means the State of West Virginia and/or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, etc. as context requires.
- J. "Vendor" or "Vendors" means any entity submitting a bid in response to the Solicitation, the entity that has been selected as the lowest responsible bidder, or the entity that has been awarded the Contract as context requires.

- k. "Will", "Shall" and "Must" identifies a mandatory item or requirement that is the duty, obligation, or requirement imposed is mandatory as opposed to being directory or permissive.

A Contract renewal shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the original contract. Delivery Order Limitations: In the event that this contract permits delivery orders, a delivery order may only be issued during the time this Contract is in effect. 5. QUANTITIES: The quantities required under this Contract shall be determined in accordance with the category that has been identified as applicable to this Contract below.

✓ **Open-End Contract:** Quantities listed in this Solicitation are approximations only, based on estimates supplied by the Agency. It is understood and agreed that the Contract shall cover the quantities actually ordered for delivery during the term of the Contract, whether more or less than the quantities shown.

Service: The scope of the service to be provided will be more clearly defined in the specifications included herewith.

Combined Service and Goods: The scope of the service and deliverable goods to be provided will be more clearly defined in the specifications included herewith.

One-Time Purchase: This Contract is for the purchase of a set quantity of goods that are identified in the specifications included herewith. Once those items have been delivered, no additional goods may be procured under this Contract without an appropriate change order approved by the Vendor, Agency, Property and Procurement Office and Attorney General's office.

6. EMERGENCY PURCHASES: The Chief Procurement Officer may authorize the Agency to purchase goods or services in the open market that Vendor would otherwise provide under this Contract if those goods or services are for immediate or expedited delivery in an emergency. Emergencies shall include, but are not limited to, delays in transportation or an unanticipated increase in the volume of work. An emergency purchase in the open market, approved by the Chief Procurement Officer, shall not constitute of breach of this Contract and shall not entitle the Vendor to any form of compensation or damages. This provision does not excuse the State from fulfilling its obligations under a One-Time Purchase contract.

7. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: All of the items checked below must be provided to the Property and Procurement Office by the Vendor as specified below.

BID BOND (Construction Only): Pursuant to the requirements contained in W. Va. 10. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other available remedy. Vendor shall pay liquidated damages in the amount specified below or as described in the specifications:

11. ACCEPTANCE: Vendor's signature on its bid, or on the certification and signature page, constitutes an offer to the State that cannot be unilaterally withdrawn, signifies that the product or service proposed by vendor meets the mandatory requirements contained in the Solicitation for that product or service, unless otherwise indicated, and signifies acceptance of the terms and conditions contained in the Solicitation unless otherwise indicated.

12 PRICING: The pricing set forth herein is firm for the life of the Contract, unless specified elsewhere within this Solicitation/Contract by the State. A Vendor's inclusion of price adjustment provisions în its bid, without an express authorization from the State in the Solicitation to do so, may result in bid disqualification. 17. FUNDING: This Contract shall continue for the term stated herein, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not

appropriated or otherwise made available, this Contract becomes void and of no effect beginning on July 1 of the fiscal year for which funding has not been appropriated or otherwise made available.

18. 19. TIME: Time is of the essence with regard to all matters of time and performance in this Contract.

20. APPLICABLE LAW: This Contract is governed by and interpreted under West Virginia law without giving effect to its choice of law principles. Any information provided in specification manuals, or any other source, verbal or written, which contradicts or violates the West Virginia Constitution, West Virginia Code or West Virginia Code of State Rules is void and of no effect.

21. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: Vendor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances. By submitting a bid, Vendor acknowledges that it has reviewed, understands, and will comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and ordinances.

SUBCONTRACTOR COMPLIANCE: Vendor shall notify all subcontractors providing commodities or services related to this Contract that as subcontractors, they too are required to comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and ordinances. Notification under this provision must occur prior to the performance of any work under the contract by the subcontractor.

22. ARBITRATION: Any references made to arbitration contained in this Contract, Vendor's bid, or in any American Institute of Architects documents pertaining to this Contract are hereby deleted, void, and of no effect.

23. MODIFICATIONS: This writing is the parties' final expression of intent. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Contract to the contrary no modification of this Contract shall be binding without mutual written consent of the Agency, and the Vendor, with approval of the Property and Procurement Office and the Attorney General's office (Attorney General approval is as to form only). Any change to existing contracts that adds work or changes contract cost, and were not included in the original contract, must be approved by the Property and Procurement Office and the Attorney General's Office (as to form) prior to the implementation of the change or commencement of work affected by the change.

24. WAIVER: The failure of either party to insist upon a strict performance of any of the terms or provision of this Contract, or to exercise any option, right, or remedy herein contained, shall not be construed as a waiver or a relinquishment for the future of such term, provision, option, right, or

remedy, but the same shall continue in full force and effect. Any waiver must be expressly stated in writing and signed by the waiving party.

25. SUBSEQUENT FORMS: The terms and conditions contained in this Contract shall supersede any and all subsequent terms and conditions which may appear on any form documents submitted by Vendor to the Agency such as price lists, order forms, invoices, sales agreements, or maintenance agreements, and includes internet websites or other electronic documents. Acceptance or use of Vendor's forms does not constitute acceptance of the terms and conditions contained thereon.

26. ASSIGNMENT: Neither this Contract nor any monies due, or to become due hereunder, may be assigned by the Vendor without the express written consent of the Agency, the Property and Procurement Office, the Attorney General's office (as to form only), and any other government agency or office that may be required to approve such assignments.

27. WARRANTY: The Vendor expressly warrants that the goods and/or services covered by this Contract will: (a) conform to the specifications, drawings, samples, or other description furnished or specified by the Agency: (b) be merchantable and fit for the purpose intended; and (c) be free from defect in material and workmanship.

28. STATE EMPLOYEES: State employees are not permitted to utilize this Contract for personal use and the Vendor is prohibited from permitting or facilitating the same.

29. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the Vendor files for bankruptcy protection, the State of West Virginia may deem this Contract null and void and terminate this Contract without notice.

30. PRIVACY, SECURITY, AND CONFIDENTIALITY: The Vendor agrees that it will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the Agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the Agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/default.html.

31. YOUR SUBMISSION IS A PUBLIC DOCUMENT: Vendor's entire response to the Solicitation and the resulting Contract are public documents. As public documents, they will be disclosed to the public following the bid/proposal opening or award of the contract, as required by the competitive bidding laws of W. Va. Code §§ 5A-3-1 et seq., 5-22-1 et seq., and 5G-1-1 et seq. and the Freedom of Information Act W. Va. Code §§ 29B-1-1 et seq.

DO NOT SUBMIT MATERIAL YOU CONSIDER TO BE CONFIDENTIAL, A TRADE SECRET, OR OTHERWISE NOT SUBJECT TO PUBLIC DISCLOSURE.

Submission of any bid, proposal, or other document to the Property and Procurement Office constitutes your explicit consent to the subsequent public disclosure of the bid, proposal, or document. The Property and Procurement Office will disclose any document labeled "confidential," "proprietary," "trade secret," "private," or labeled with any other claim against public disclosure of the documents, to include any "trade secrets" as defined by W. Va. Code § 47-22-1 et seq. All submissions are subject to public disclosure without notice.

32. LICENSING: In accordance with West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Series IV Purchasing Guidelines and Policies, §6.1.d.1., Vendor must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agency or political subdivision. Upon request, the Vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Property and Procurement Office's Chief Procurement Officer or the Agency to verify that the Vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

SUBCONTRACTOR COMPLIANCE: Vendor shall notify all subcontractors providing commodities or services related to this Contract that as subcontractors, they too are required to be licensed, in good standing, and up-to-date on all state and local obligations as described in this section. 33. 35. VENDOR RELATIONSHIP: The relationship of the Vendor to the State shall be that of an independent contractor and no principal-agent relationship or employer-employee relationship is contemplated or created by this Contract. The Vendor as an independent contractor is solely liable for the acts and omissions of its employees and agents. Vendor shall be responsible for selecting, supervising, and compensating any and all individuals employed pursuant to the terms of this Solicitation and resulting contract. Neither the Vendor, nor any employees or subcontractors of the

Vendor, shall be deemed to be employees of the State for any purpose whatsoever. Vendor shall be exclusively responsible for payment of employees and contractors for all wages and salaries, taxes, withholding payments, penalties, fees, fringe benefits, professional liability insurance premiums, contributions to insurance and pension, or other deferred compensation plans, including but not limited to, Workers' Compensation and Social Security obligations, licensing fees, etc. and the filing of all necessary documents, forms, and returns pertinent to all of the foregoing.

Vendor shall hold harmless the State and shall provide the State and Agency with a defense against any and all claims including, but not limited to, the foregoing payments, withholdings, contributions, taxes, Social Security taxes, and employer income tax returns.

36. CONFLICT OF INTEREST: Vendor, its officers or members or employees, shall not presently have or acquire an interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict with or compromise the performance of its obligations hereunder. Vendor shall periodically inquire of its officers, members, and employees to ensure that a conflict of interest does not arise. Any conflict of interest discovered shall be promptly presented in detail to the Agency.

40. REPORTS: Vendor shall provide the Agency with the following reports identified by a checked box below:

41. PREFERENCE FOR USE OF DOMESTIC STEEL PRODUCTS: Except when authorized by the Director of the Purchasing Division pursuant to W. Va. Code § 5A-3-56, no contractor may use or supply steel products for a State Contract Project other than those steel products made in the United States. A contractor who uses steel products in violation of this section may be subject to civil penalties pursuant to W. Va. Code § 5A-3-56. As used in this section:

a. "State Contract Project" means any erection or construction of, or any addition to, alteration of or other improvement to any building or structure, including, but not limited to, roads or highways, or the installation of any heating or cooling or ventilating plants or other equipment, or the supply of and materials for such projects, pursuant to a contract with the State of West Virginia for which bids were solicited on or after June 6, 2001.

b. "Steel Products" means products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forged, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed, or processed by a combination of two or more or such operations, from steel made by the open heath, basic oxygen, electric furnace. Bessemer or other steel making process. The Purchasing Division Director may, in writing, authorize the use of foreign steel products if:

c. The cost for each contract item used does not exceed one tenth of one percent (.1%) of the total contract cost or two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), whichever is greater. For the purposes of this section, the cost is the value of the steel product as delivered to the project; or

d. The Director of the Purchasing Division determines that specified steel materials are not produced in the United States in sufficient quantity or otherwise are not reasonably available to meet contract requirements.

42 PREFERENCE FOR USE OF DOMESTIC ALUMINUM, GLASS, AND STEEL: In accordance with W. Va. Code § 5-19-1 et seq., and W. Va. CSR § 148-10-1 et seq., for every contract or subcontract, subject to the limitations contained herein, for the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair, improvement or maintenance of public works or for the purchase of any item of machinery or equipment to be used at sites of public works, only domestic aluminum, glass or steel products shall be supplied unless the spending officer determines, in writing, after the receipt of offers or bids, (1) that the cost of domestic aluminum, glass or steel products is unreasonable or inconsistent with the public interest of the State of West Virginia, (2) that domestic aluminum, glass or steel products are not produced in sufficient quantities to meet the contract requirements, or (3) the available domestic aluminum, glass, or steel do not meet the contract specifications. This provision only applies to public works contracts awarded in amount more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or public works contracts that require more than ten thousand pounds of steel products.

The cost of domestic aluminum, glass, or steel products may be unreasonable if the cost is more than twenty percent (20%) of the bid or offered price for foreign made aluminum, glass, or steel products. If the domestic aluminum, glass or steel products to be supplied or produced in a "substantial labor surplus area", as defined by the United States Department of Labor, the cost of domestic aluminum, glass, or steel products may be unreasonable if the cost is more than thirty percent (30%) of the bid or offered price for foreign made aluminum, glass, or steel products.

This preference shall be applied to an item of machinery or equipment, as indicated above, when the item is a single unit of equipment or machinery manufactured primarily of aluminum, glass or steel, is part of a public works contract and has the sole purpose or of being a permanent part of a single public works project. This provision does not apply to equipment or machinery purchased by a spending unit for use by that spending unit and not as part of a single public works project.

All bids and offers including domestic aluminum, glass or steel products that exceed bid or offer prices including foreign aluminum, glass or steel products after application of the preferences provided in this provision may be reduced to a price equal to or lower than the lowest bid or offer price for foreign aluminum, glass or steel products plus the applicable preference. If the reduced bid or offer prices are made in writing and supersede the prior bid or offer prices, all bids or offers, including the reduced bid, or offer prices, will be reevaluated in accordance with this rule.

43. INTERESTED PARTY SUPPLEMENTAL DISCLOSURE: W. Va. SPECIFICATIONS

- PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is soliciting bids on behalf of the Parks and Recreation Section to establish an Open-End contract for propane at Cacapon Resort State Park. The contract will include equipment, installation, maintenance, fill and refill of propane tanks for the Park located at 818 Cacapon Lodge Drive, Berkeley Springs, WV 25411 in Morgan County.
- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 2.1 "Contract Item" or "Contract Items" means the list of items identified in Agency 3.1 below and on the Pricing Pages.
 - 22 "OPIS" means Oil Price Information Service as published by United Communications Group, 1300 Rockville Pike, Suite 1100, Rockville, MD 20852 1-800-929-4824.
 - 23 "Pricing Pages" means the schedule of prices, estimated order quantity, and totals contained in wvOASIS or attached hereto as Exhibit A, upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Services.
 - 2.4 "Solicitation" means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.
 - 25 "The Park" means Cacapon Resort State Park.
 - 26 "Usage Requirements" means the amount of propane necessary for the operation of Cacapon Resort State Park.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Contract Items and Mandatory Requirements: Vendor shall provide Agency with the Contract Items listed below on an open-end and continuing basis. Contract Items must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements as shown below.

- 3.1 On demand Vendor must provide and install: four (4) one thousand (1000) gallon tanks, fifteen (15) five hundred (500) gallon tanks, one (1) five hundred (500) gallon underground tank, one (1) one hundred twenty-four (124) gallon tank and twenty-one (21) one hundred twenty (120) gallon tanks as set forth on the attached map *Exhibit B*.
 - **3.1.1** Tanks shall be set, but not affixed to concrete pavers near the facility in which they will service.

- **3.1.2** Contract includes all labor and material for removal of existing Vendor units. Contract includes all labor and material for installation of new Vendor units.
 - 3.1.2.1 One (1) Five hundred (500) gallon underground tank will be dug up, if it is replaced.
- 3.1.3 <u>Vendor is responsible to the point where service enters the building.</u> Vendor must be responsible for all exterior equipment which includes tanks, lines and regulators to the building in which the tank serves.
 - **3.13.1** Contract must include service and maintenance of all supplies and equipment to the exterior of the facility that is serviced which includes tanks, lines and regulators.
- 3.1.4 The Park will be responsible for the interior equipment, which is defined as the interior gas lines, ranges, ovens, heaters, fireplaces, tank-less on demand water heaters and furnaces.
- 3.2 Vendor shall fill eighteen (18) State owned one thousand (1000) gallon tanks located at "tank farm". (See map Exhibit B).
 - 3.2.1 <u>Vendor is responsible for equipment from State owned tank to the point</u> where service enters the building. Vendor is responsible for all exterior equipment, excluding the State owned tanks, which includes lines and regulators to the building in which the State tank serves.
 - 321.1 Contract must include service and maintenance of all supplies and equipment to the exterior of the facility that is serviced which includes tanks, lines and regulators.
- 3.3 Usage of propane varies by demand due to weather conditions and park visitation. Usage is defined as propane sufficient to meet said demand.
- 3.4 Vendor must provide a twenty-four (24) hour emergency response number. Emergency response number must be affixed to the exterior of each tank and readily visible.
- 35 Vendor must place the facility on an "automatic fill" program. The object of the automatic fill program is to eliminate the need for Agency personnel to monitor fuel levels and place orders, while at the same time not running the risk of being without fuel. It is the intent of the Agency that "manual" orders of this type to be the exception and shall only be used in other than normal circumstances.

- 3.5.1 Vendor must replenish the Parks fuel tanks automatically without an order being placed by the Agency personnel. Automatic refill schedule will be established once the Agency and Vendor have determined accurate delivery timeframes.
- **3.5.2** Vendor is responsible for maintaining a program to have sufficient LP gas for use by the Park thus to minimize the possibility of emergency fuel deliveries. The Park will not pay additional fees for emergency fuel deliveries due to the Vendor's failure to provide sufficient LP gas.
- 3.6 The Vendor, along with assistance from the Park, will be responsible for the coordination of the changeover of exterior equipment with the current vendor. The changeover may consist of any existing tanks, transfer, replacement, etc. with the current vendor, to assure safe transfer in accordance with all Federal, State, County and local governing regulations and codes.
 - **3.6.1** Unused propane product removed during installation, and not transferred into any new Vendor tanks must be credited to Cacapon Resort State Park at the stated contract price. This procedure must be completed with a metered truck, written down and delivered to Cacapon Resort State Park office.
 - **3.6.2** Tanks are to be in good condition, clean, painted and have a valid recertification stamp. Tanks must be set per a schedule that will be provided by the Park in order to mitigate disruption of Park services. Vendor may not disrupt use by Park guests. Lines, regulators and devices as provided by the vendor must be free of defects or shall be repaired immediately.
 - **3.6.3** Removal of equipment, and or supplies, shall be at no expense to the Park. Any damage or unsafe condition caused by removal must be repaired immediately and at no charge to the Park.
- 3.7 A winter additive, or sufficient sizing of regulator as provided by the Vendor for wintry weather to prevent lines from freezing, must be included for all tanks.
- **38** Vendors must provide proof of quality of the product provided at any time during the life of the contract. Such proof may include the identity and location of the refiner producing the fuel and the exact specifications/content of the fuel. Vendors must be an established refiner, distributor or dealer. In the event any adulterated or substandard fuel is delivered, all costs associated with the emptying and cleaning of Cacapon Resort State Park tank(s) will be the responsibility of the Vendor.
 - **3.8.1** Annual testing of the Vendor owned equipment consisting of valves, regulators, gauges, tanks and any other equipment to ensure proper operations shall be considered and documented by no later than the 15th of January each year.

- **3.8.2** Replacement of defective equipment shall be done immediately at no additional cost to the Park. Proof of testing must be provided to the Park within thirty (30) days of said testing, at no additional cost to the Park. Testing results are subject to the approval of the Park.

Theory of Operation

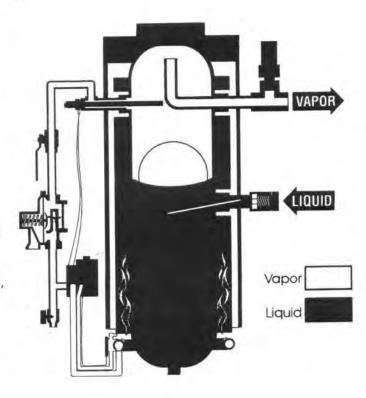

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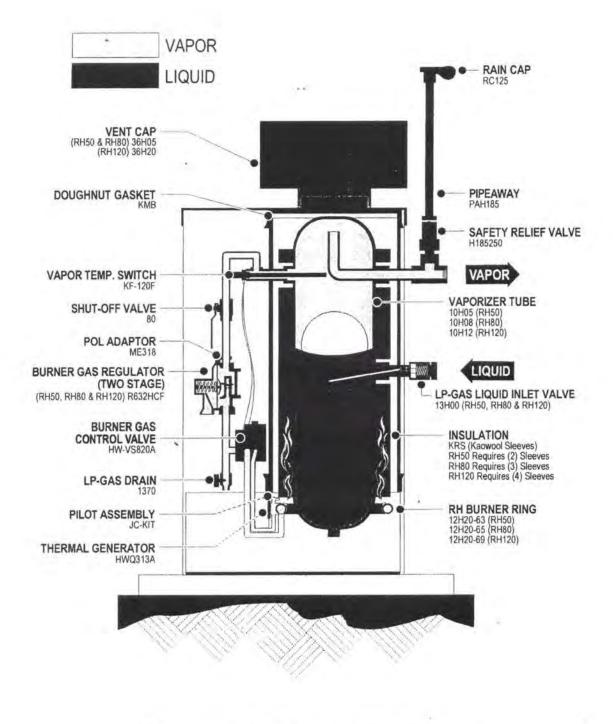
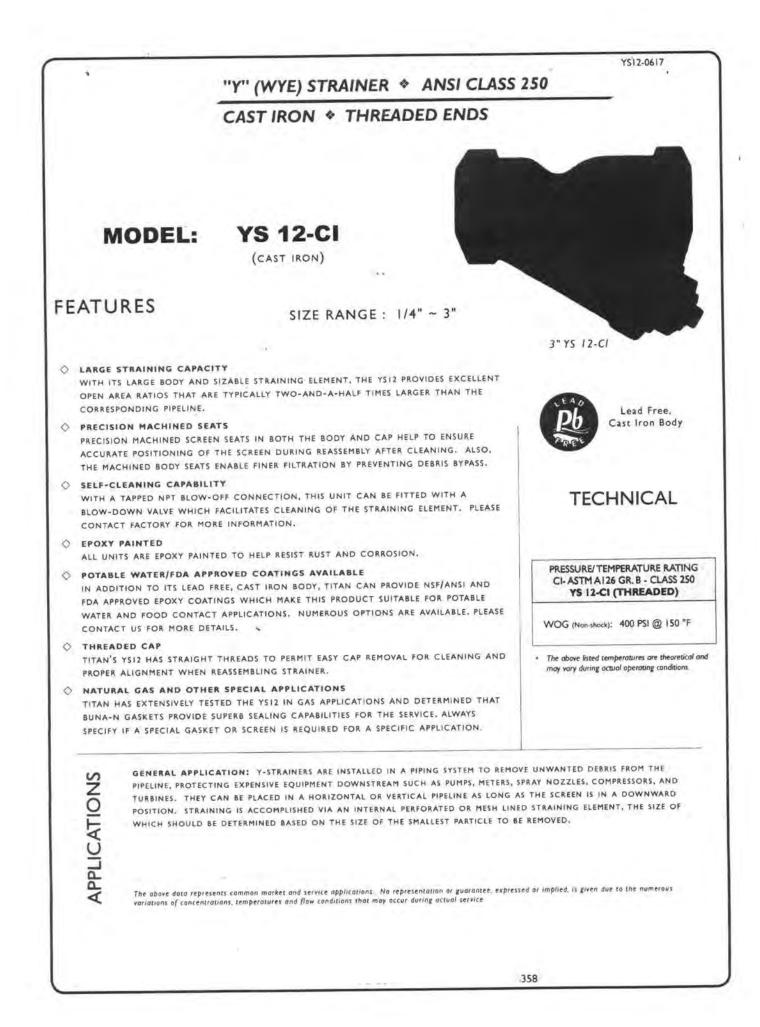


Figure 6-2 -- RH80
