

EASTERN SPADEFOOT

(Scaphiopus holbrooki) Length: 1 3/4-31/4 inches

What to look for: stout body; sickle-shaped "spade" on inner side of hind foot; front toes slightly webbed; eyes with vertical pupils; irregular pale lines often

extended backward from eyes.

Habitat: sandy, gravelly, or loamy soil; from farmland to forest
