

## WEST VIRGINIA MASTER ANGLER PROGRAM

Beginning in 2022, the WVDNR implemented the Master Angler Program to promote fishing and recognize anglers for their accomplishments over a wide range of species and ecosystems.

## **RULES**

- Angler must legally catch all species listed for the specific slam
- Each catch must meet or exceed the minimum lengths for that species
- Time-stamped photos of the angler holding each species must be submitted with the application
- Each slam must be completed within a calendar year to qualify
- If an angler completes all six slams, he/she will be awarded a West Virginia Master Angler Award which will be a lifetime achievement for an angler.
- The Master Angler award does not need to be completed in a calendar year.
