

## Section I. General

- **1.01** This agency requires permits for the transport of all fish into the State of West Virginia.
- **1.01.a** Each permit application must be filled out completely listing all species to be transported and the date of the transport.
- **1.01.b** Each permit is valid for only one trip into the State with the approved species on the approved date.
- **1.01.c** The source of the fish must be listed as the exact business name where purchased and the waterbody where collected if wild fish.

Chapter 20213 of the Code of West Virginia states that importers of fish or viable eggs of the family salmonidae (trout, salmon, etc.) must furnish a statement from a recognized fish pathologist certifying the source to be free of whirling disease, infectious pancreatic necrosis, viral hemorrhagic septicemia or other diseases which may threaten fish stocks.
