3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

 - **3.1.5** Prefer minimum 30" high sides, minimum 94" beam, with a minimum 25" transom.
 - **3.1.6** Must have starboard side console with preferences for the following:
 - **3.1.6.1** Hydraulic steering wheel
 - **3.1.6.2** Angled, shatterproof windshield
 - **3.1.6.3** Right side throttle control

- **3.1.7** Must have front deck with preferences for the following:
 - **3.1.7.1** Minimum 42" deep front deck with Dri-Deck or equivalent non-slip flooring.
 - **3.1.7.2** Kick plate footswitches (may be used independently).

 - **3.1.7.4** Washouts on either side
- **3.1.8** Must have tread plate aluminum floor with non-slip cover or treatment.

 - **3.1.17.1** Batteries must be charged by either motor and/or generator.
- **3.1.18** Must have independent on-board battery for motors and generator with boxes/trays and strap downs.
- **3.1.19** Must have automatic bilge pump that can also be operated manually with a minimum of 500gph.
- **3.1.20** Must have audible navigation signaling device (horn).
- **3.1.21** Must have console mounted LED work lights to illuminate the working area around the livewell.
- **3.1.22** Must have shallow water anchor (power pole).
- **3.1.23** Must have extra storage in rear and at least one (1) side for gear/equipment that is water resistant and secure with latches.
- **3.1.24** Must have minimum 25-gallon aluminum EPA compliant fuel tank, mounted under bow deck with fill line protected from water and must not interfere with deck work.

3.3 Inverter Generator, New and Unused

- **3.3.1** Must be compatible with commercially manufactured air-cooled inverter generator.
- **3.3.2** Must have a minimum displacement 380cc.
- **3.3.3** Must have AC Output with 120/240 volts and be 7000 minimum watts.

- **3.3.5** Must have a five-gallon minimum fuel tank capacity.

- **3.4.3** Must have dual axle.
- **3.4.4** Must have hydraulic surge disc braking system.
- **3.4.5** Must have 2-inch coupler.
- **3.4.6** Must have waterproof LED lights.
- **3.4.7** Must have heavy-duty winch and safety chain.
- **3.4.8** Must have mounted spare tire.
- **3.4.9** Must have transom-mounted straps.
- **3.4.10** Must have minimum 36" guide bunks.
- **3.4.11** Must have bunks equipped with low friction slides.
 - **3.4.11.1** Must have roller bunks for *3.1*.
- **3.4.12** Prefer metal fenders with anti-slip pads.
 - **3.4.12.1** Must be strong enough to support, at least, a 250-pound person.
- **3.4.13** Must have at minimum, 13" wheels.
- **3.4.14** Trailer tires must be 10-ply.

3.5 Contract must be fulfilled and items delivered/received on or before April 1, 2026. This is a grant-related procurement with a non-renewable expiration date. Product must be received for payment to be released.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

4.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide the Agency with a purchase price for the Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.

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4.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by providing a unit price per line item that includes shipping or delivery fees. 6.2 Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if the shipment of the Contract Items will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to the Agency will be ground for cancellation of the Contract, and/or obtaining the Contract Items from a third party.

Any Section seeking to obtain the Contract Items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval from the Chief Procurement Officer.

- **6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss:** Vendor shall deliver the Contract Items F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location.
- **6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items:** If the Agency deems the Contract Items to be unacceptable, the Contract Items shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned product shall either be replaced, or the Agency shall receive full credit or refund for the purchase price, at the Agency's discretion.
- **6.5 Return Due to Agency Error**: Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 30 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall not charge a restocking fee if returned products are in a resalable condition. Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking

- **7.2** The following remedies shall be available to Agency upon default.
 - **7.2.1** Immediate cancellation of the Contract.
 - **7.2.2** Immediate cancellation of one or more release orders issued under this Contract.
 - **7.2.3** Any other remedies available in law or equity.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. Code* §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.
